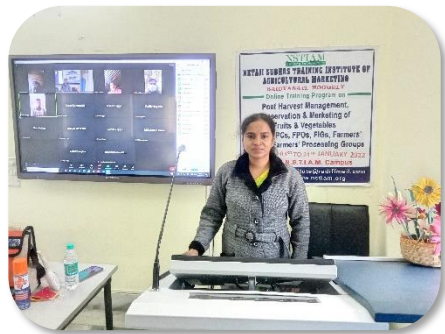

Different trainings throughout the quarter



In order to impart up-to-date knowledge on the e-NAM software along with hands on training on the software, NSTIAM introduced online training on e-NAM for the RMC officials and other Stakeholders of e-NAM from 04-10-2021 onwards. The Institute has successfully completed 02 number 3-days online trainings for RMC/ZRMC officials and 16 number of 2-days online training for Progressive Stakeholders during this quarter. For Progressive Stakeholders, each batch was consisted representatives of Progressive farmers, FPO/FPC members & Progressive traders.
